- \* Year-round salary and employment with NSA after graduation
- \* You must be a U.S. citizen
- \* You must be a high school senior at time of application
- \* You must achieve a minimum ACT of 25 or SAT/College Board score of 1600 (1100 Critical Reading and Math, 500 in Writing)
- \* You must have at least a 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale
- \* You must demonstrate leadership abilities
