UW Alumni Association Scholarships

Each year, the University of Wyoming Alumni Association awards License Plate Funded Scholarship-In State to graduating high school seniors who will be attending UW in the fall. The funding is \$6,000 for four years, paid over eight consecutive semesters, provided the recipient maintains a 2.5 cumulative grade point average while taking a minimum of 12 credit hours each semester. Recipients must be attending UW at the Laramie Campus. Students will only be able *to apply* for scholarships once they have been accepted to attend the University of Wyoming and will need their WyoWeb username and password to apply.
