Registration for all students will include the following activities:

- 1. Check in & verify that your “NCSD Parental Agreements & NCHS Handbook Acknowledgement are completed in Infinite Campus Parent Portal. If these are not done you will continue with registration, but you will NOT receive your technology.**
- 2. Picture - Required** You DO NOT have to purchase a picture packet, but all students **MUST** have their photo taken for ID card purposes. Please check your email to order pictures prior to verification. If you did not receive an e-mail, you can go to mylifetouch.com and use the Picture Day ID: EVTX8WQFZ to order your packet online. Picture packets will also be available at the photo station.
- 3. Parking pass (Parking passes are limited and will only be issued to students who return the “Code of Conduct and Registration”, which is enclosed)**
- Schedule folder picked up
- Student ID & grade-level lanyards picked up
- Check out iPads (iPads will only be issued to students who have completed their online “NCSD Parental Agreements & NCHS Handbook Acknowledgement”)
- Set- up Food Services Account (Funds may be deposited during registration and checks should be payable to NCHS).
- Pick up free grade level t-shirt and planner.
