Registration for all students will include the following activities:

1. **Check in & verify that your “NCS Parental Agreements & NCHS Handbook Acknowledgement are completed. If these are not done you will continue with registration, but you will NOT receive your technology.**
2. **Picture - Required** You DO NOT have to purchase a picture packet, but all students **MUST** have their photo taken for Digital ID card purposes. If writing a check, make payable to “Lifetouch” . You will be able to purchase pictures online at mylifetouch.com and use the Picture Day ID: **EVTZQFGCH** Picture packets will also be available at the photo station.
3. **Parking pass (Parking passes are limited and will only be issued to students who return the “Code of Conduct and Registration”, which is enclosed)**
4. Minga Digital ID information will be given out. Please see the enclosed flier for set-up instructions.
5. Check out iPads (iPads will only be issued to students who have completed their online “NCS Parental Agreements & NCHS Handbook Acknowledgement”)

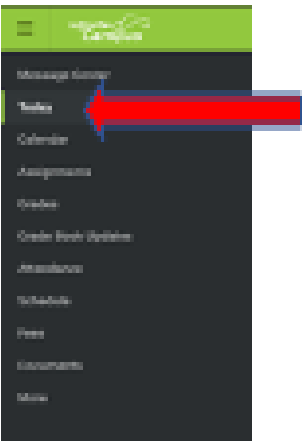
These steps must be completed before the registration process at NCHS can be completed.

1. Login to your Infinite Campus parent portal. If you do not have a login, please call 307-253-5306.

If you have more than one student in the district you will have to choose the correct student in the drop down on the top left of your screen. You can Copy the ID number from this screen.



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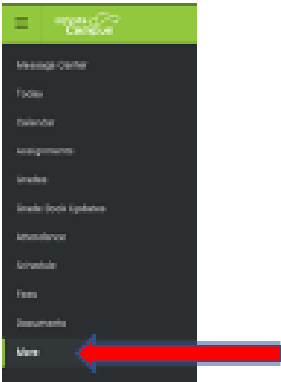

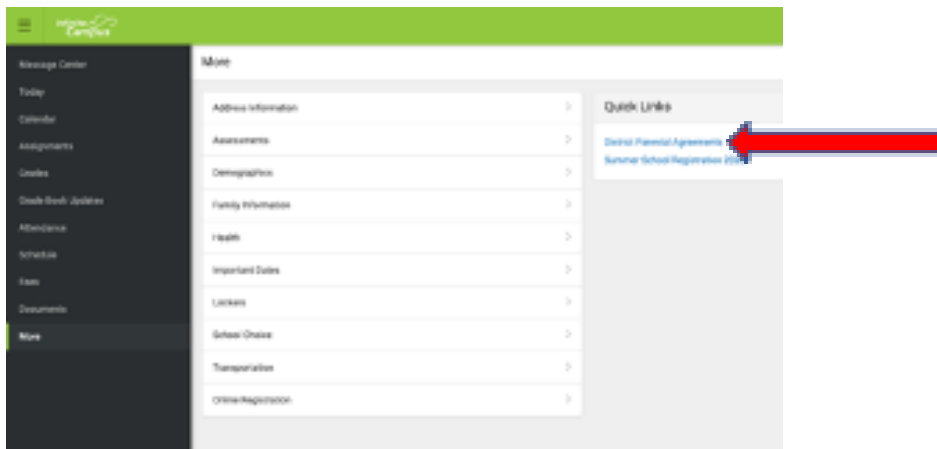

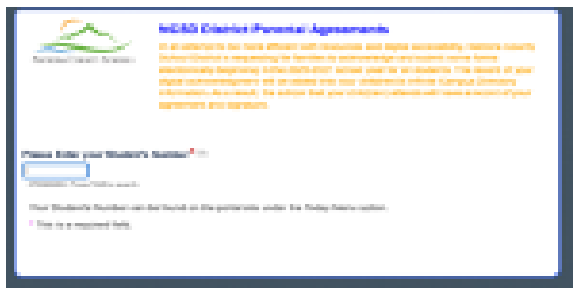
4. After you copy the students 2700##### number you will then click on “More”

ZERO Advertising Policy

Minga never advertises to students and student or school data is never used to target or direct advertising in any way. Ever.

Content Filtering and Moderation

We have a three (3) step approach to ensure the integrity of content posted to your school Minga.

1. Member Accountability: There is no anonymous accounts on Minga; every student is represented by their real name. This reduces inappropriate behavior by 99.9%.
2. AI Filtering and Moderation: The Minga AI Engine automatically scans every post and comment for offensive words, phrases and emojis in addition to content representing bullying, sexting, racism and discrimination. This content is blocked in real time and the user and administrator are notified.
3. Reporting and Deleting: Anyone on your Minga can report offside content and you can set a report threshold to automatically remove it. Any teacher or administrator can immediately delete content in real time.
