Directions for Online Course Selection

- ❖ Go to natronaschools.org
- ❖ Select Infinite Campus Portal Login (bright green button) located on the right side of the homepage
- ❖ Select Campus Student
- ❖ Enter username and password - If you have never logged onto the portal:
 - Username is Student ID number
 - If you have not set up your own password then it is the initials of your first and last name with your birthdate ex. ba102899

- ❖ Click on the word **More**; this is located at the bottom on the left side of the screen
- ❖ Click on **Course Registration** which is located on the left of the screen
- ❖ Click on **Natrona County HS 21-22**
- ❖ Click on **Add Course**
- ❖ Search course. For example English I, type in English
- ❖ Click on requested course and then the **Add Request** button on the bottom
- ❖ To add additional courses, select **Back** at the top to find the course search option
- ❖ You will see that the course now has a **red X** next to it. This means you have selected it as a course option.
- ❖ Make sure you select both first and second semester for each class, unless it is a semester or intensive course.
- ❖ You will need to do this for each course selected on your enrollment form.
- ❖ If you accidentally pick the wrong course, it can easily be deleted by clicking on the red X.
- ❖ To see your entire list, you can click the back option until you come to the screen that lists the courses you have picked.
- ❖ If you see something in your list you don't want there, you can select it and click on the delete button at the bottom of the screen.
- ❖ Disregard the percentage at the top of the screen.
