- \* Tuition and fees up to \$30,000 per year
- \* Housing and travel entitlements during summer employment (if the distance between NSA and the school exceeds 75 miles)
- \* Year-round salary and employment with NSA after graduation
- \* You must be a U.S. citizen
- \* You must be a high school senior at time of application
- \* You must achieve a minimum ACT of 25
- \* You must have at least a 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale
- \* You must demonstrate leadership abilities
